

# 5th Annual Jennifer Templeton 4v4 Memorial Tournament

## Age Divisions: Girls and Boys Co-ed divisions

**U8: 8/1/04-7/31/06**

**U10: 8/1/02-7/31/04**

**U12: 8/1/00-7/31/02**

**U14: 8/1/98-7/31/00**

**HS: 8/1/93-7/31/98**

**Adult:** Anyone born after 7/31/93

## Rules:

No coaching permitted at any time – Only assistance for substitutions.

4 players permitted on the court.

Must have even distribution of female and male players.

2 female players must be on the court at all times.

Substitutions allowed on the fly.

No offsides.

No goalies.

Kick-in for balls crossing the touchline.

No playing off walls permitted.

For balls passed over the goal line last touched by offensive team -

Goal kick is awarded to defending team ten feet in front of goal.

Ball is not in play until it leaves defined penalty area (three point arc).

Player kicking ball may not contact ball again until touched by another player.

For balls passed over the goal line last touched by defensive team -

Corner kick is awarded to offensive team.

Maximum roster size = 6

Minimum roster size = 4

Minimum number of players needed to play game = 3

If team does not have 3 or more players at the scheduled start time, the team lacking players will forfeit, 1-0. Players can then swap teams as they would like and scrimmage with a referee for the remaining time.

Ties end in ties – no overtimes.

Games are 20 minutes in duration with no half-time.

## Play-off Rules:

Tournament points will be rewarded as follows:

Win: 3 points

Tie: 1 points

Loss: 0 points

In the event of a tie between teams that would advance to the Semi-finals:

- Head to Head competition: If the two teams that are tied have played each other in the preliminary round, the winner of that game will receive the higher standing. (Not used if more than two teams tied.)
- Goal Differential (up to five per game)
- Goals Allowed (fewest)
- Goals Scored (up to five per game)
- Coin flip

In playoff games, no tournament points are awarded – the team with the most goals advances.

In the event of a tie, there will be a single 5 minute overtime period. If the game is tied after 5 minutes, golden goal rules will apply and the first to score will advance.
